Music Class Expectations

- I. Professional Music Procedures**
 - A. Demonstrate group support and be active listeners when other sections are getting assistance.
 - B. Instruments should remain silent until tuning is complete.
 - C. Place books and other unnecessary items on shelf in the Instrument storage room when entering the classroom.

- II. Prepare to Perform**
 - A. After the tardy bell rings, we have two minutes to be in assigned seats with music out.
 - B. Practice Proper posture by sitting up straight and feet flat on the floor.

- III. Safety First**
 - A. Walk at all times.
 - B. Play your assigned instrument.

- IV. Respect Self and Others**
 - A. Encourage each person to keep trying.
 - B. Raise hand and wait to be called upon by the teacher to talk.
 - C. Be positive in participation, facial expressions, smiling, clapping and be willing to try new techniques.

Before and After School Rehearsals and Concerts

After School Rehearsals for 7th and 8th grade Chorus will be held on Tuesday's as needed. Students will receive a grade for attendance. Rehearsal begins promptly and students will not receive full credit for being late. These meetings are important for blending the choir and having rehearsal time together as one group. These are required rehearsals.

After School Rehearsals for 7th and 8th grade Orchestra will be held Monday afternoons from 2:55p.m. until 3:25p.m. beginning Monday, October 3, 2011. Transportation should be at LCMA promptly at 3:30p.m. If you cannot be picked up by 3:30, then an alternate assignment will be given. Rehearsal begins promptly and students will not receive full credit for being late.

Concerts

100% Participation is expected at all concerts. The only exception is an unavoidable absence with a written parental excuse turned in two weeks in advance of concert, or in the event of extreme illness, accident, family emergency such as accident, family emergency, or family funeral. In the event of an excused performance, a written

comprehensive exam will be given to the student to make up lost points. Each concert should be treated as a final exam in an academic class.

Grades

The grading period is based on these criteria:

- D. Written Tests
- E. Before and After School Rehearsals
- F. Performances

Students may receive extra credit by attending concerts. They may receive up to 100 points extra credit (50 points per concert).
